Details of the Bursary

Value: \$1,000

Bursaries Available Annually: 14 (1 for each Markham High School)

Deadline for students: April 29, 2011

Qualifications: The *Markham District Energy Sustainability Bursary* encourages and rewards graduating Markham high school students who have distinguished themselves through environmental community service, extracurricular and volunteer activities, and academic excellence; and who intend to study sciences related to the environment at a Canadian post-secondary institution.

Selection Process:

- Recipients are selected by the individual schools. Talk to your school if you are interested in being considered and submit a one page (300 word max) typed essay to your school on why you deserve to be awarded the *Markham District Energy Sustainability Bursary* as per the qualifications noted above. This will allow your school a fair selection process and will serve as an explanation to MDE why the selected student was chosen for the Bursary.
- Selected students will be invited, along with two guests, to an Awards Ceremony at the June 14th Town of Markham Council meeting, where they will be formally recognized by the Mayor, members of Council, and Markham District Energy.
- Recognition of the bursary award will also be announced at the 14 high school graduations.
- Awarded students will be acknowledged on MDE's website and in a media release.
- Each bursary cheque will be sent directly to the bursary recipient upon proof of full-time enrollment at a Canadian post-secondary program. A letter to each bursary recipient will confirm these details.
